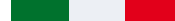

## history

A over 50-year international leadership in **glass-blowing** and manufacturing of high-tech scientific instrumentation is the origin of the whole project. Founded in the mid 19th century by Luigi Falocci, father of Steroglass current Directors Stefano and Roberto, “Soffieria Perugina” has always seen a continuing favourable trend as distribution has been added to glass-blowing production and subsequently to instrumentation manufacturing. Today Steroglass is a leading name in the scientific field worldwide.

The Blueside project originated with Roberto Falocci's **passion** and initiative. Steroglass can boast unique unparalleled skilled hands able to finely process and **shape glass** and whose great craftsmanship guarantees excellence, thus deserving a key role beyond conventional technical sectors.

All this combined with love for **design**, **music** and **cuisine**, until then only passion, in 2009 resulted in a diversified production and commercial project dedicated to design complements to **dining** and **living** world, which take inspiration from **blues** and **jazz** as well as giving the **emotion** that inspires a musician on stage and the audience in an atmospheric performance.

## mastery and craftsmanship

Today hand **glass** blowing is an increasingly rare art; indeed it is an art of patience, fire, heat and precision.

However, shaping **glass** is not so easy. Being one of the most perfect and complex materials, glass never betrays those who know and love it.

Shaping glass means tradition and requires expertise. Artistry and craftsmanship, accurate and technical at the same time, resulted in the **Blueside** project. Not to mention Steroglass great mechanical, electronic and design skills have really added extra value.

All of the objects in the collection are handcrafted one at a time. Each piece created by the expert hands of our glassblowers becomes unique, resembling others but definitely different from all of them, and this allows us to create shapes that are often impossible to make using molds or machinery, thus consecrating their high added value. It is also worth emphasizing that some of our products, such as the Chocolate Pot and the Tazzezen cups for coffee or tea, guarantee maximum strength and safety when subjected to thermal shock.





## materials

Glass in the first place in all its shapes and sizes. Mainly borosilicate glass: the purest and most neutral existing glass, most resistant to thermal shock, contaminants-free ... a higher quality product.

While glass means tradition, several other different and technological materials can be also used: **DuPont™ Corian®, ceramics, porcelain, wood, aluminium, steel, stone ...**

Above all, skills to work with these various materials put few limits to creativity and workmanship.

Moon was designed seeking the best compromise between a shape that is comfortable to hold and the best possible olfactory perception.

The semispherical thick-walled design guarantees that the ideal temperature is maintained; with the double foot, it can be set in a vertical position for pouring the spirits and a second, inclined position for increasing the surface of the liquid exposed to the air as much as possible, so as to enhance the aromas.

Genio ("genie"), which resembles the famous "Aladdin's lamp," is held intimately in the palm of the hand, transmitting the warmth of the hand to the spirit, to bring out its aroma and flavour.

Timeless was designed to help create the right meditative atmosphere for tasting passito or meditation wines, but it is also just right for an aperitif at sunset by the sea... or to sit back and relax with a cup of tea. Perfect for holding in a small space a glass, small tidbits to go along with it, and aromatic or decorative elements that harmonize to enhance the scents and the flavour sensations of the drink you are about to taste. There is also space for a small pencil and a flat, smooth stone on which you can note down your ideas and the sensations experienced while contemplating the tastes, perhaps even jotting down your more poetic thoughts - why ever not?

Available in three different versions:  
THENO for tea and herbal teas, with a teacup in borosilicate glass, little accompanying sweets on a small round glass plate and a minimal composition of stones, water and maybe even fresh flower petals on a small elongated glass plate.  
SUNSET for aperitifs, with a white wine glass, tapas and finger food on the small round glass plate and a small decorative composition on the elongated glass plate.  
GILBERTO for after dinner and meditation wines, with a dessert wine glass, a small round glass plate for serving small pastries or blue cheese and with elongated glass plate for dried fruit & nuts, spices and flowers that hint at the olfactory nuances of the beverage we are about to taste.  
Other types of glasses can be used to open up a wide variety of possibilities, such as chocolate, cigars and rum.

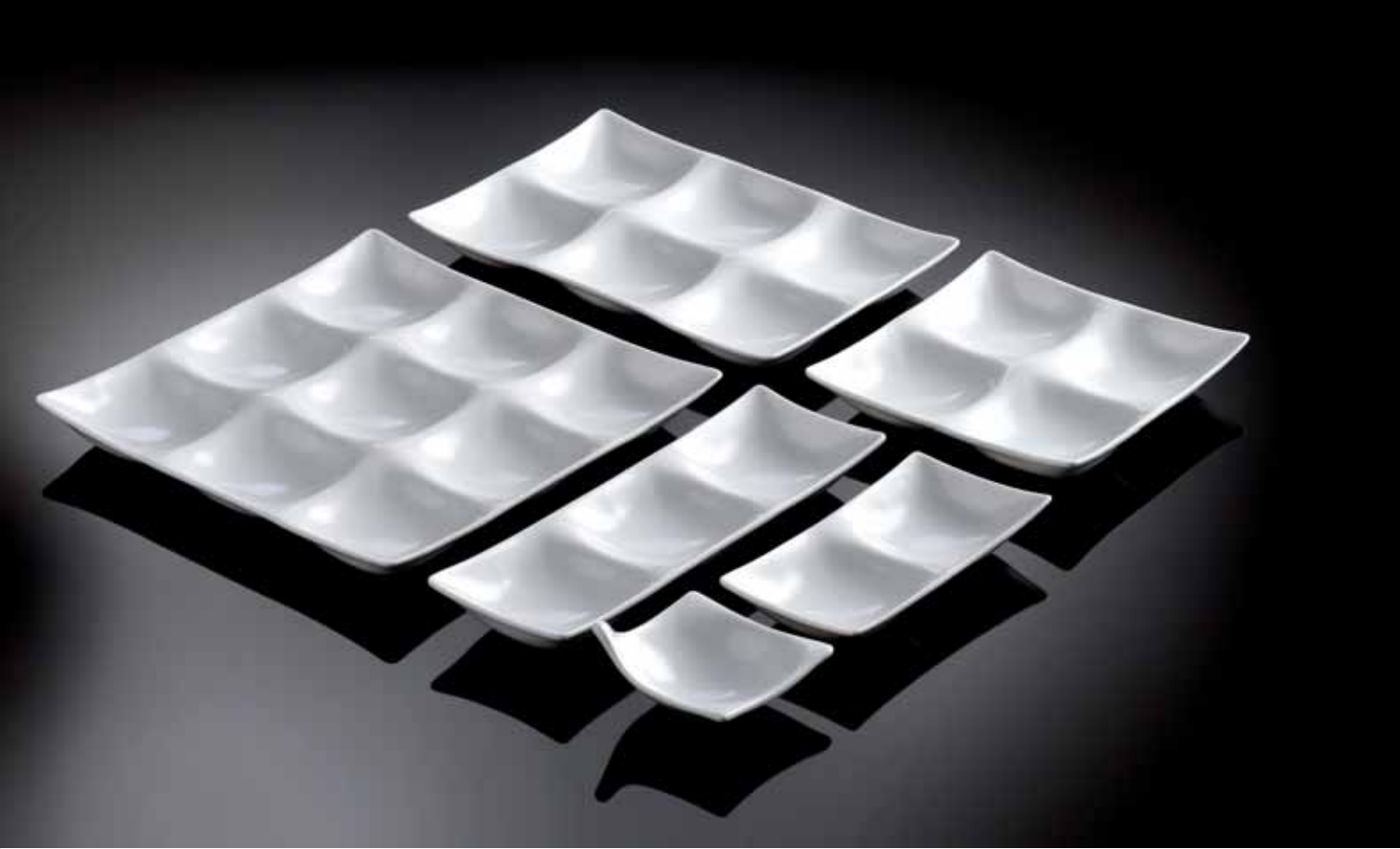

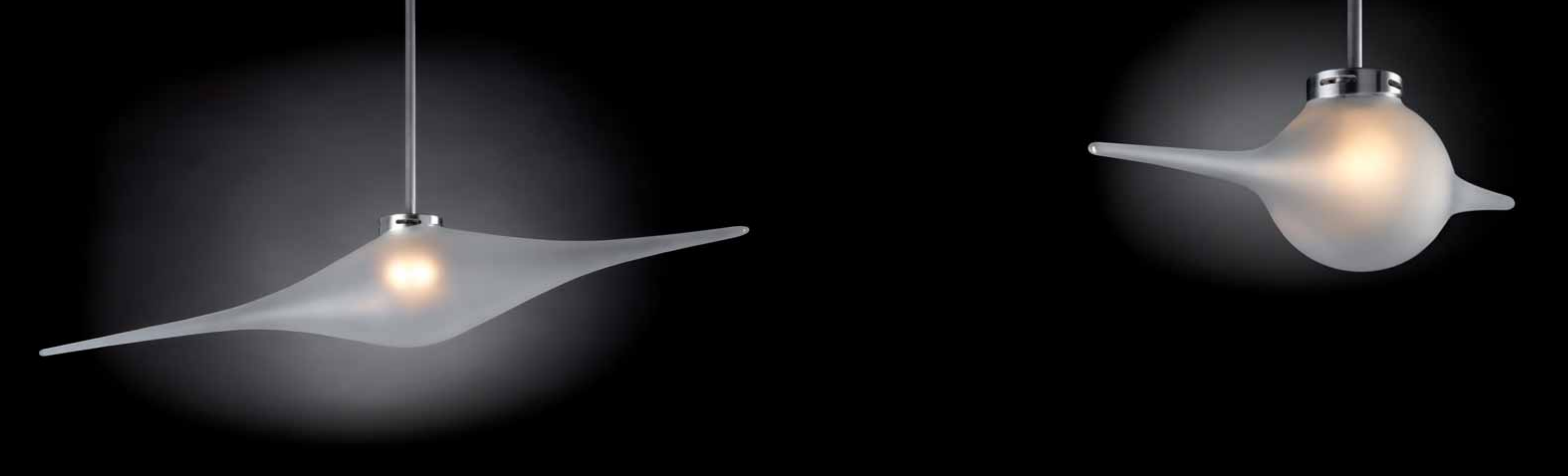

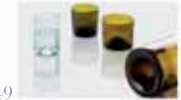
